Teucrium aroanium	GREY CREEP	Nice, grey evergreen clumps. Spread to 18-24". Has a nice show of light purple flowers through summer
Teucrium chamaedris	GERMANDER	Semi-evergreen shrublet, Spreads to make groundcover, dry partial shade, takes pruning well, cut back after blooming to promote bushiness
Thymus serpyllum 'MAGIC CARP	THYME	Grows vigorously with extra water. Trim faded flowers.
Veronica 'Blue Reflection'	creeping speed	has the vigor and heat tolerance of blue wooly speedwell and blue flowers of turkish speedwell
Veronica incana	SILBERSEE	Grey-White foliage with blue flowers. Looks nice all year
Veronica liwanensis	TURKISH SPE	Needs afternoon shade. Vigorous, fast growing, groundcover
Veronica longifolia		Tall upright plants with long terminal spikes of clear blue flowers- cutflower
Veronica oltensis	THYME-LEAF	Slow growing, long lived groundcover, rock garden, evergreen foliage
Veronica prostrata	NESTOR	Stems are hairy. Mat forming. May not be fully hardy here.
Veronica teucrium	ROYAL BLUE	Gentian blue flowers, bushy plant.
Zauschneria arizonica	HUMMINGBIR	Thrives in hot sun, well drained soil. May spread by rhiizomes
Zauschneria garrettii 'ORANGE C	HUMMINGBIR	Plant Select 2001. Masses of scarlet-orange blossoms. The hardiest of the genus and very long-lived.
Zinnia grandiflora	PRAIRIE ZINN	Long bloom season. Blooms dry to pale yellow and remain on plant. Spreads slowly by reseeding or by underground roots to form colonies
